“Our teenage and young adult leaders benefit from the leadership development experience, and the children love the

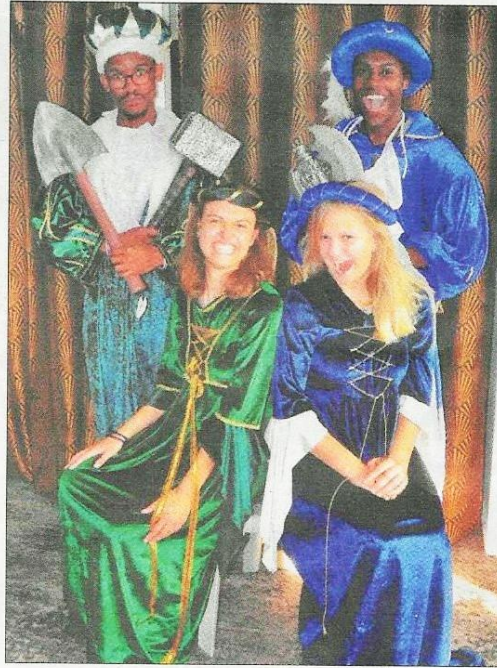
opportunity to get involved in activities which are guaranteed to overcome the chilly weather.”
